

## **Instructions for Extended Abstracts / Full Papers Submission via EasyChair**

The extended abstracts/full papers submission for ICGH10 will be managed through 'EasyChair'. The authors can submit and update their extended abstracts / full papers through this system before the prescribed deadline provided on the ICGH10 website. Please note that submission of extended abstracts/full papers does not constitute registration for the conference. All participants must register and pay the appropriate registration fees. For more information, please visit the conference website.

This document is intended to assist authors for their submissions of extended abstracts/full papers. It includes three parts:

1. Login to EasyChair
2. Add files to your accepted submissions
3. Update the submission information if necessary

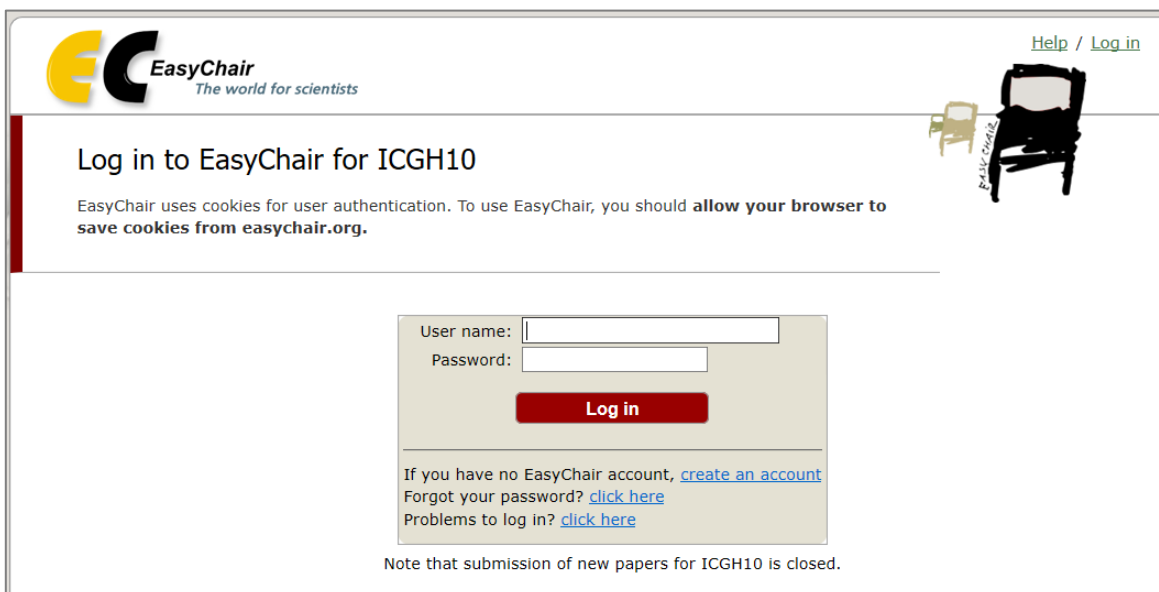

## 1. Login to EasyChair

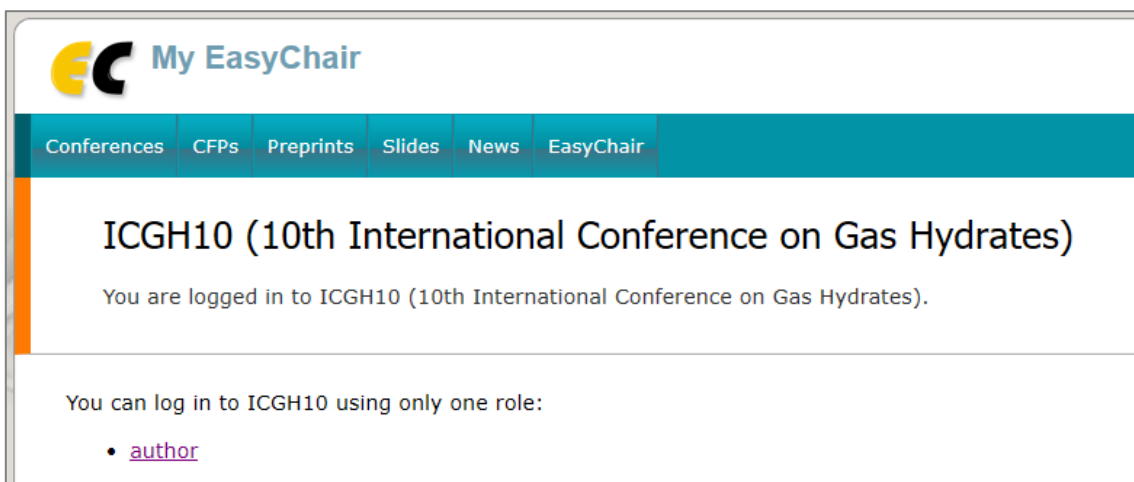
Proceed to the EasyChair page for ICGH10: <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=icgh10>

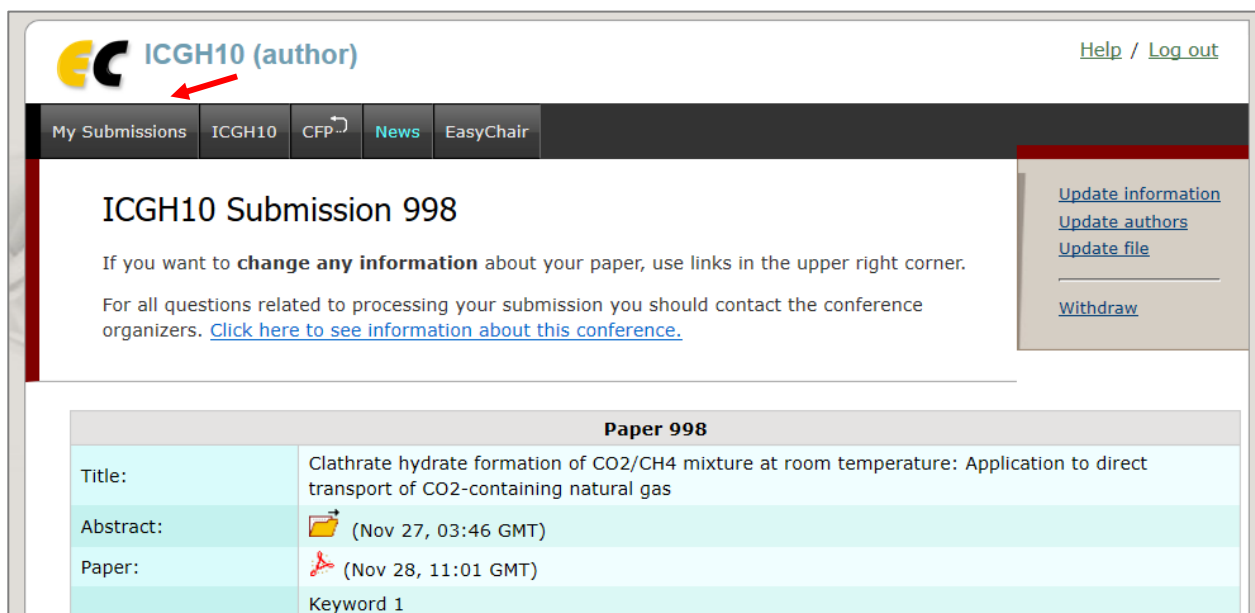
